Note 1599-6903 - due to biennial rate reviews, the FY'2023 Chapter 257 figures is the relevant figure for comparison. House Ways and Means supports Gov's 2025 Chapter 257 request of \$390 Million; Still working to confirm \$95 Million from the Economic Development plan for Ch. 257. Budget language in several line items **requires MassHealth to maintain PCA eligibility services in 2025 as in 2024-- need Senate to concur.** We can confirm the DESE-DDS figure of \$10.5 Million thanks to House Ways and Means. Hope to see the health equity- OHC investment continue.
